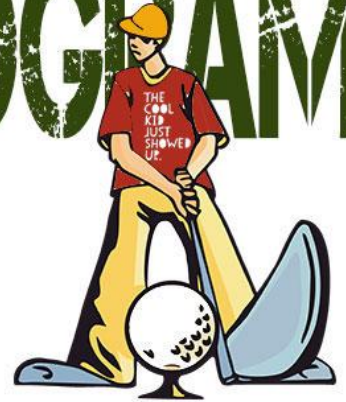

## JUNIOR PROGRAM EVENTS OVERVIEW

### **1. Group Lessons**

- 3-one hour group lessons (Golf course etiquette and basic rules, swing fundamentals, putting and chipping).
- Dates of lessons: Saturdays, June 13<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> starting at 9am (times may vary). All participants are required to register for the lessons and confirmation of times will be emailed on Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> to all registrants.

### **2. Summer Camps**

- 2- two day (2 hours each day) summer junior camps.
- Golf course etiquette and introduction to the rules of golf, basic swing fundamentals, putting, chipping and pitching).
- Video instruction for the older students.
- Date of camps: Times of each session TBA
  - Saturday and Sunday - July 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>
  - Saturday and Sunday – August 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>

**3. Weekly Play Days**

- Held Sunday afternoons (July 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, August, 9<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>)
- Junior golfers (ages 12-18 years old) will play nine holes and junior-junior golfers (ages 5 to 11 years old) will play 3 holes.
- Fun competition each week.

**4. \* Parent-Child windup golf tournament**

- Sunday, August 23<sup>th</sup> beginning at 5pm.
- 9 hole (shotgun start depending on enrolment)
- Dinner and prizes to follow.
- Lots of fun.
- Entry fee applies.
